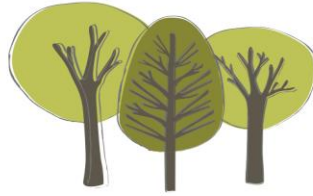
MAY 2021

Social Committee – Brandi Lee, Chair

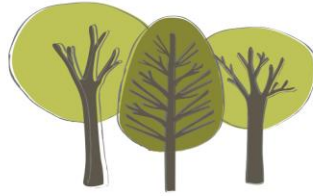
